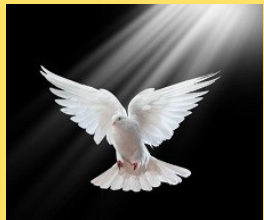

SPEAKER Cyril John was born in Kerala, India, in 1957. Baptised in the Holy Spirit in 1982 he was Coordinator of the Delhi Crusaders an intercession ministry and a prayer group leader in Delhi until 1994. He was Chairman of the Delhi Archdiocesan Service Committee until 2000 and Coordinator of the National Intercession Network in India and Member and Vice-chair and Chairman of the National Service Committee of the CCR in India and Chairman of NSC.

Cyril is a member of ICCRS Council since 2004 and the Chairman of ICCRS Sub-Committee for Asia-Oceania (ISAO) since 2006. Cyril works as Director in Lok Sabha, Lower House of the Indian Parliament, and lives in New Delhi with his wife and their four children. In April 2007 Cyril was elected Vice-President of the ICCRS Council. He has written Pray Lifting up Holy Hands, the prayer of Intercession, 2012 and is an international speaker on prophetic intercession and other topics in the Catholic Charismatic Renewal.

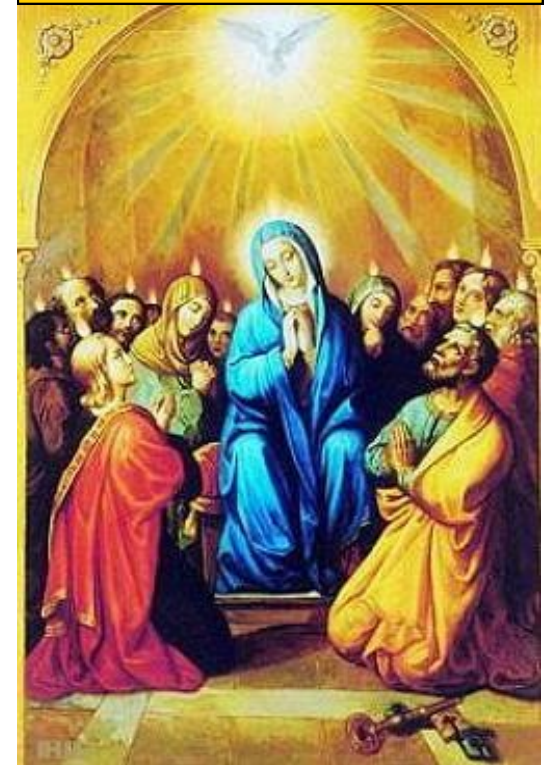
