He is also very involved as a member of ICCRS (International Catholic Charismatic Service) in Rome and is serving as the final chair as ICCRS dissolves into a Vatican Dicastery, CHARIS, the National Association of Diocesans (former) and the Director of the Holy Spirit institute. Jim resides with his lovely wife Susan, and his 20-year-old son John in Michigan.
